

Presentation Secondary School, Ballingarry.

There has been a school on this site in Ballingarry since 1871. Established by the Presentation sisters, the first school was a primary school, a boarding school for girls followed, a day school for girls was added, and then a mixed secondary. Now, Presentation Secondary School, Ballingarry is a rural co-educational school, in the tradition of the Presentation Sisters and under the trusteeship of CEIST. It cherishes values and is committed to justice and answering the needs of our times under the guidance of the CEIST Charter. Presentation Secondary School gives priority to –

The school opened an extension with refurbishment in 2015 and have been granted funding for ASD Accommodation plus three classrooms.

The school has a Gym, Astroturf, Sports Hall and field. 14 classrooms, a sensory room, prayer room, two labs, DCG/Graphics room, Wood Tech room, Art Room, music room, a small library and Home Economics kitchen.
